Regulation

"Publications for cumulative doctorates prior to admission as a doctoral candidate"

The doctoral committee decides:

At least two publications that can be accepted for a cumulative doctorate should have been published or accepted for publication in a peer-reviewed, internationally recognized journal during the doctoral period, i.e. after admission as a doctoral student at the Doctoral Center SGW. A maximum of one publication that has been accepted by a peer-reviewed, internationally recognized journal before admission to the Doctoral Center or has been published within a maximum of one year before admission and for which the supervisor is co-author or first author, if possible, will be recognized for the cumulative doctorate at the Doctoral Center SGW.

Reason for the decision:

This regulation prevents,

- 1) that publications are recognized for the cumulative doctorate that were published without supervision by the Doctoral Center,
- 2) that publications are recognized for the cumulative doctorate that could already be (soon) outdated before the doctoral student is admitted to the Doctoral Center,
- 3) that more than a maximum of one publication lies outside the actual doctoral period. The fact that a publication may lie outside the doctoral period takes into account the possibility that both the doctoral candidate and the potential supervisor may decide to pursue a doctorate or supervision only after the publication has been accepted or published.
